Master Class 1999

At a recent meeting of National Council it was resolved to conduct a Master Class for Grade 1 and Grade 2 arbitrators in each State. The format for the Master Class will differ from past classes. The new format is as follows:

- 1. There will not be any set talks/papers/presentations.
- 2. At least two months prior to the Class, all participants will be requested by the local Chapter Administrator or Secretary to suggest topics/issues for discussion at the meeting.
- 3. The topics/issues will be grouped and allocated to sessions as appropriate by the Chapter Administrator in each State.
- 4. A summary of the various sessions and questions for each session will be circulated to each participant at least one month prior to the Class.
- 5. A facilitator will be appointed for the Class by the Chapter Committee.
- 6. Two assessors will be appointed for each Class including the Chairman of the Education & Training Committee or his nominee [who will attempt to be present at all classes in each State].
- 7. The assessors will report on the performance and contribution of each participant, such participation, it is expected, will reflect the arbitrators' level of knowledge and experience.
- 8. The result of the assessment will form part of the tri-annual review of graded arbitrators.
