Master Class 1999

At a recent meeting of National Council it was resolved to conduct a Master Class for Grade 1 and Grade 2 arbitrators in each State. The format for the Master Class will differ from past classes. The new format is as follows:

1. There will not be any set talks/papers/presentations.
2. At least two months prior to the Class, all participants will be requested by the local Chapter Administrator or Secretary to suggest topics/issues for discussion at the meeting.
3. The topics/issues will be grouped and allocated to sessions as appropriate by the Chapter Administrator in each State.
4. A summary of the various sessions and questions for each session will be circulated to each participant at least one month prior to the Class.
5. A facilitator will be appointed for the Class by the Chapter Committee.
6. Two assessors will be appointed for each Class including the Chairman of the Education & Training Committee or his nominee [who will attempt to be present at all classes in each State].
7. The assessors will report on the performance and contribution of each participant, such participation, it is expected, will reflect the arbitrators' level of knowledge and experience.
8. The result of the assessment will form part of the tri-annual review of graded arbitrators.
