

# **SOUTH AUSTRALIAN VICTIMS OF CRIME SERVICE IN MEMBERSHIP DRIVE**

The high profile Victims of Crime Service (Inc.) in South Australia recently announced that they were looking to recruit more members to meet the increasing demands of their organisation.

"We need to double our present membership of 2,500", Executive Director, Andrew Paterson said in launching the membership drive.

Already our organisation has seven full-time professional staff and one hundred active volunteers who assist thousands of crime victims each year, offering support, counselling, information and advocacy.

Members of Victims of Crime have the opportunity to contribute to the organisation's work through payment of a small annual subscription. The subscription entitles them to receive a quarterly newsletter and provides access to library and other facilities managed by the organisation.

"The more members we are able to recruit, the more people become aware of our work and the more that awareness spreads to the wider community", Andrew Paterson said.

Victims of Crime in South Australia is one of the longest running organisations in Australia concerned for the plight and well-being of victims.


