
CLASS 1020 GRADUATES

The picture shows Sergeants Gary Wood and Barry Pumphrey at the grave of an RAAF member, Flight Sergeant Alex Manners who died while serving with 46 Squadron RAF on 31 August 1943. Some of the details on the headstone are wrong. Alex trained with the RAAF at Cunderding and Geraldton in Western Australia and in Britain where he was seconded to 46 Squadron RAF flying Beaufighters.

The motto on the headstone, 'We rise to conquer' is that of 46 Squadron RAF.

Alex's father, Alexander G Manners, still lives at 164 Eighth Avenue, Inglewood, Western Australia.
