Preface

The creation of the Australian Year Book of International Law was entirely due to the efforts of Mr. J. G. Starke, Q.C., with the support and encouragement of Messrs. W. H. Nichols and F. C. Judson of Butterworth & Co. (Aust.) Ltd., Sydney. As Editor, Mr. Starke piloted it through the first two volumes, with the goodwill and co-operation of contributors.
