A new career low for Morris & Withnall: failed to obtain a judgment by consent.

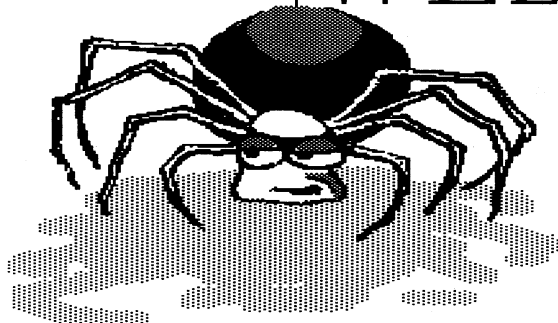
## OBSCURER
