## BANKRUPTCIES FOR FIRST QUARTER

Federal Justice Minister Duncan Kerr has released provisional bankruptcy statistics for the January to March quarter, 1994.

The statistics show an overall decrease of nine per cent in administrations under the Bankruptcy Act (comprising Bankruptcies, Deeds of Arrangement and Assignment and Compositions) for this quarter over the same period in 1993.
