Administrative Law Prize & Copyright Law Prize

The Centre for International and Public Law at the Australian National University announces details of the two above-named prizes.

The AIAL (Australian Institution of Administrative Law) Prize in Administrative Law attracts a prize of \$2000 which will be awarded to the author of an essay displaying original thinking on a topic of the author's choice relating to administrative law. The essay should be 8,000 - 10,000 words in length and the closing date for the prize is 1 March 1997. The winning entry will be determined by the Executive of the Institute and will be published by the Institute.

The 1997 GC O'Donnell Copyright Esay Prize is awarded in honour of Gus O'Donnell, founder of the Australian Copyright Council.

The prize will be awarded to the author of an essay displaying original thinking on a topic of the author's choice, relating to copyright and the protection of the interests of others.

The \$3000 prize will be adjudged by the Trustees of the G C O'Donnell Biennial Prize Trust and will be published in the *Copyright Reporter*, journal of the Copyright Society of Australia. Closing date for entries is 1 May 1997.
