Video Conferencing Facilities – Alice Springs

The Registrar of the Law Courts in Alice Springs has issued the following advice which applies to all video conferencing required by a party in a court proceeding:

The party booking the facility must:

- 1. Contact the List clerk on 8951 5713 to book the time for the conference.
- 2. Confirm the booking in writing to the relevant officer of the court and undertake to pay the applicable fees.
- 3. Include in the confirmation the details of the location to be called. These details must include:
 - (a) The phone number(s) to be called to connect to the remote conference facility and that facility' description.
 - (b) A contact name and telephone number of a person at the remote facility.
 - (c) The commencement time and expected length of the conference.
 - (d) The details of the relevant case, including the name of the witness.

The costs of the facility are as follows:

\$200 per site called for the first hour, then \$25 per 1/4 hour after the first hour, plus telstra transmission costs. The transmission costs will also include the time taken to set up prior to the conference.


