



## Wyndham Estate

Wyndham Estate is part of the large South Australian-based Orlando Wyndham group. Ando took over the Wyndham group in 1990 giving it a substantial holding in NSW, and a very strong market acceptance in that state. Committed to quality and enjoying a renaissance in its viticulture practices and premium wine production led by a dedicated team including Don Lester and Phil Laffer, it has recently celebrated a major milestone, its 170th anniversary, which no other wine company in the country can claim.

Purchased in 1828 by George Wyndham, then only 27 years old, the property was called Anmandale. Renaming it Dalwood, it wasn't until 1970 that it was changed to Wyndham Estate. Over those 170 years Wyndham Estate has been through several changes in name, ownership and success. The first vintage was in 1835. In 1860 Dalwood was awarded a Gold medal for the 1860 Australian Wine at International Exposition. The use of contract growers to supply fruit is very important to Wyndham Estate and that is where the greatest expansion in supply will ultimately come from.

Semillon and Shiraz account for 70% of the area planted and Chardonnay another 25%. The remainder is split between Cabernet Sauvignon and the Merlot.

Mudgee is where the main production is undertaken with the Dalwood Winery producing the Reserve range wines using basket presses and traditional winemaking techniques.

Wyndham Estate markets a substantial range of red and white table wines. The Triple Bin Number range is the main one. The Reserve range is top of the group, produced in limited quantity from only Hunter Valley fruit. The

Oak Cask Chardonnay and Cabernet Merlot are middle range. A fairly recent addition, the Cuvee Vintage Brut has only been available for twelve months or so.

The winery, tasting facilities and restaurants are situated in the historic winery building overlooking the bush vineyards. A traditional winery using open fermenters and 100-year old basket presses operates. Daily tours can be taken by visitors.

There is little doubt that Wyndham Estate intends to continue to expand both in range, quantity and quality. Wyndham Estate is still winning the world over.
