Funds for this purchase were donated by Jane's parents, Sir Curtis and Lady Keeble, and we thank them for their donation.

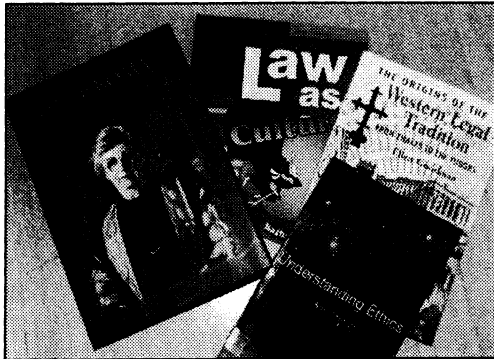
Jane Mahoney was a respected member of the legal profession who died tragically with her husband Tony in a motor vehicle accident on the Cox Peninsula Road in July 1998.
