

# STREAMLINE

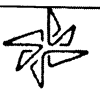
STREAMLINE is Australia's computer-based water information network. It is mounted on the ACI Ausinet system, under the online name WATR, and is ACI's newest protegee; their 21st database.

STREAMLINE contains details of 850 current water research projects in Australia for which over 1300 organisations were approached. In addition, from late June, the database will provide references to journal articles, books, reports, conference papers and theses on all facets of water and wastewater from 1982 onwards. In future, more than 4000 references each year will be included in STREAMLINE. Subject coverage includes floodplain management, land use effects, changes in ecosystems, groundwater assessment, drinking-water quality, household, industrial and mining pollution, water distribution, power generation and water conservation.

It is anticipated that STREAMLINE will be of value to ecologists, water planners, scientists, environmentalists, hydrologists, engineers ... in fact, everyone interested in water.

STREAMLINE is co-ordinated by the Department of Resources and Energy, Water Branch, and a network of participating centres has been established based on the major water agency librarians in each State. Any of these groups may be contacted for further information on STREAMLINE.

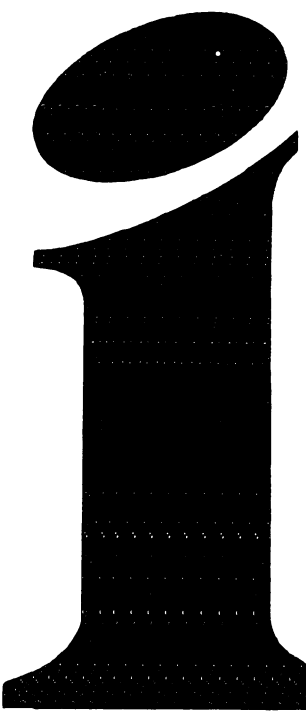
