

Down Under is Tops

One of the many remarkable things about Australia is that there's still so much of it to explore, to photograph, to write about . . .

And this is especially true of the waters surrounding Australia's coastline. They conceal a fascinating and beautiful world that remains a secret to most people. But a new book has recently appeared which describes in text and brilliant photography that hidden world. Written by Christine A Deacon with more than 200 photographs by Kevin Deacon, *Australia Down Under* was published by Doubleday and costs \$35.00 (ISBN 0 86824 241 1).

Users of the 5th Edition of the *National 16mm Feature Film Catalogue* published in 1984 will find the Supplement to this edition indispensable as many changes have occurred during the last two years. Distributors have merged and the availability of films on video is having an effect on feature film distribution.

The Supplement is published by the National Library in association with the Australian Council of Film Societies and the Australian Film Commission and lists over 1500 new titles with around 200 deletions.

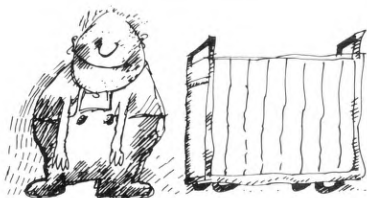
