New BLDSC source

Exclusive agency for the British Library Document Supply Centre (BLDSC)

AS FROM APRIL, DA Books & Journals has been supplying pre-paid units to libraries, thus providing customers with quick and easy access to important documents. These documents may be articles from books, journals, research reports, conference papers or other information required for research or private study.

Photocopy requests may also be made by Automated Request Transmissions such as computer, telex or fax. Deductions are made from BLDSC Deposit Account when requests are satisfied. Each unit—costing just £5.00, approximately A\$9.40—entitles the holder to up to ten pages of photocopied material. A document request is fulfilled when the customer sends a coupon and their free order form or makes an automated request transmission to the BLDSC. The requested article is sent directly by airmail to the library. Documents are paid for in Australian dollars directly converted from the British Pound.

BLDSC also offers a Copyright Cleared Service. For a small premium this service protects you from copyright infringement if you make multiple copies, etc.

For very urgent photocopy requests, a reply can be sent via fax on the same day, provided the customer holds a deposit account with the BLDSC.
