NSW parliamentary publications to be more accessible

Richard Baker describes how the recent microfiche release will help librarians and their readers

OME New South Wales parliamentary series are now available for the first time on microfiche. The complete set of Journals of the Legislative Council, Votes and Proceedings of the Legislative Assembly, and Parliamentary Papers is being produced on microfiche for the Parliament, by Styfox Pty Ltd beginning with the second Session, 48th Parliament (1984-86). The set retails for \$577 and consists of approximately 600 microfiche in acid free envelopes presented in a cloth covered box. To illustrate the storage savings involved, the same set in hard copy consists of 20 thick quarto volumes! The third Session 48th Parliament (1986-1988) will also be available in mid 1992, consisting of approximately 900 microfiche in acid free envelopes, presented in a cloth covered box, at a cost of \$910. The same set in hard copy amounts to 35 volumes.

The New South Wales Parliamentary Library has been heavily involved at all stages in developing and advising Styfox in this project, which it hoped will make these New South Wales Parliamentary publications more widely and easily accessible.
