

## New deadlines for Events

**E**vents is now published as a separate insert, like *ALIAppointments*, rather than as part of the text. This allows us to improve our service to you by making a big reduction in the lead time between the deadline for *Events* and their appearance in print.

In future the *Events* deadline will be first post (10.00 am) on the day before *ALIAppointments*, shortening last year's lead time by ten days.

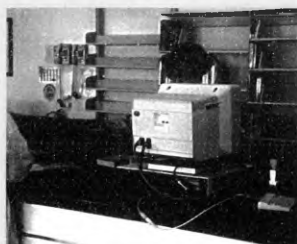
