report on the AUSTEL inquiry into the telecommunications needs of access seekers and providers has been released. The original request for submissions, released in early October, sought views on the key requirements of access seekers and consumers and the types of consultation processes which should be adopted by a newly formulated Telecommunications Access Forum (TAF) to ensure that the needs of access seekers and consumers would be taken into account during the development of an access code and the determination of declared services.

The Association's submission to this inguiry argued that equity issues in the access to communications services should be a central consideration when developing regulatory regimes. The report quoted comments made in the ALIA submission on the identification of declared services. in particular the need to become outcomerather than process-focused.

The report noted that in order to best represent the stakeholders in telecommunications, the Telecommunications Access Forum would need to have comprehensive representation, encompass appropriate consultation processes and time frames in its constitution and structure and require an independent chair.
