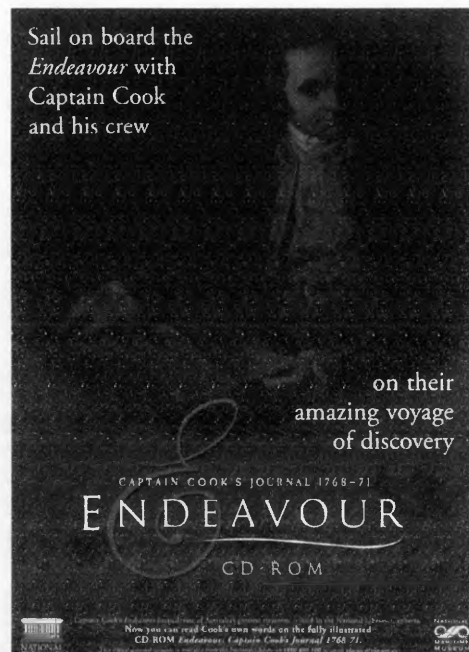
What is PAM-APF?
