

Search for business heroes

The search for innovative Australian businesses making their mark by selling products and services overseas has begun with the launch of the 39th Australian Export Awards. The Minister for Trade, Mark Vaile, launched the 39th Australian Export Awards in Sydney on 7 May.

The Awards recognise achievers in ten industry categories (agribusiness, arts and entertainment, education, emerging exporter, information industries, large advanced manufacturer, minerals, regional exporter, small to medium manufacturer, and services) and three special award categories, The Austrade International Award, The Special Achievement Award, and the DHL Australian Exporter of the Year.

The Australian Export Awards are one of the longest running and most prestigious business awards in Australia, recognising excellence in exporting and promoting the export sectors high achievers as role models of the business community. The Australian Trade Commission (Austrade) and the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ACCI) are the joint presenters of the national awards.

Companies of all sizes, industries and locations are urged to nominate for the national award categories by entering their State/ Territory Export Awards. State winners automatically progress through to the national awards, which will be presented in November.

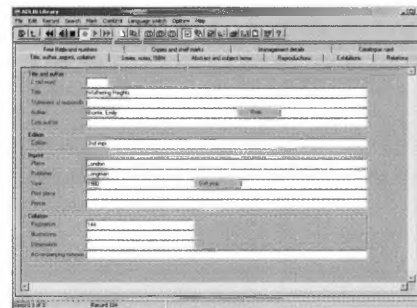
