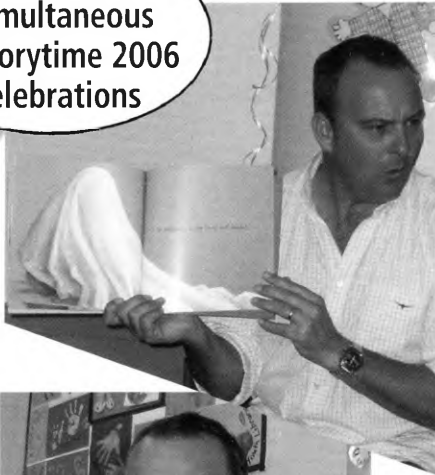




National Simultaneous Storytime 2006 Celebrations

Andrew Daddo, author, signing one of the many books purchased at NSS 2006



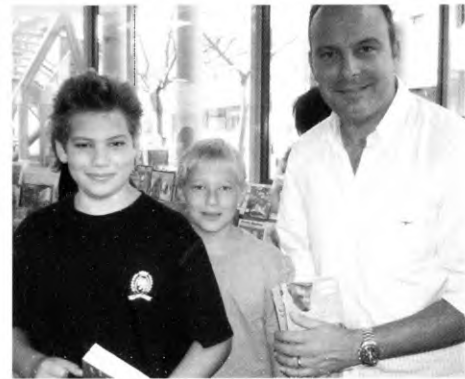

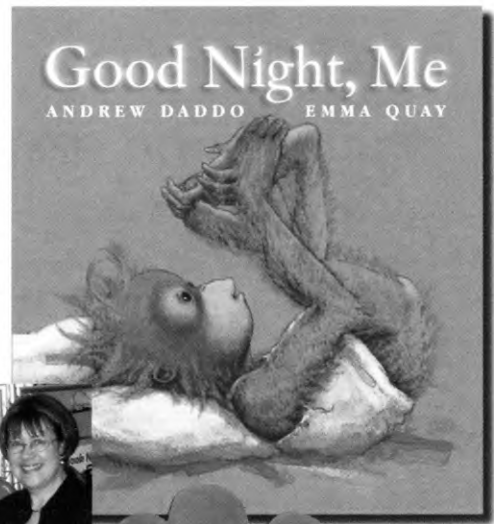
Librarian, Michelle Campbell took NSS to two local schools
