Apply now for a Churchill Fellowship – an award of opportunity

A Churchill Fellowship, through the provision of financial support, enables Australian citizens from many walks of life to travel overseas to undertake an analysis, study or investigation of a project or an issue that cannot be readily undertaken in Australia. Currently the average Fellowship cost is \$25 000. You must be over 18 to apply for a Fellowship. Many librarians over the years have benefited from the Fellowships, most recently (2005) Janice Nitschke – it could be you next!



ALIA's South Australian members should also note that there is a sponsored Churchill Fellowship, the Jean Primrose Whyte Fellowship for library and information services, restricted to residents of South Australia. To the best of my knowledge it was not awarded this year: there must be South Australians working in the LIS sector who are over 18 and have a good idea that merits investigation.

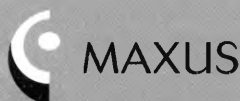
