

# News about our journals

We are pleased to announce that from 1 January 2013, *Australian Library Journal* and *Australian Academic and Research Libraries* will be published by Taylor & Francis under its Routledge imprint.

Our highly regarded journals provide an essential vehicle for publishing scholarly research, and although some associations have pulled out of journal publishing entirely, the ALIA Board has been actively seeking a publishing model that will be affordable, will recognise the call for more open access, will give LIS academics a prestigious outlet for their work, will provide members with access to scholarly research, and will bring Australian research to the attention of a wider audience internationally. After 12 months spent reviewing the current arrangements and exploring the many options available, a contract has been negotiated

with Taylor & Francis, licensing the publisher to produce and distribute ALJ and AARL. The journals will be part of Routledge's LIS journal project which allows contributors to its library and information science journals to retain the copyright to their work and to post their manuscript (version following peer review) within their institutional repository without an embargo period.

Institutional members will continue to receive their copy of ALJ, and will gain online access via IP address. Individual members who subscribe will continue to receive their choice of journal in printed format and/or online via username and password through Taylor & Francis Online.
