Author Rights Pilot from Routledge/ Taylor & Francis

n 2011, Taylor & Francis introduced an author rights pilot across 35 Library and Information Science journals, including ALIA's new journal, the Journal of the Australian Library and Information Association (JALIA). Many authors have taken advantage of this pilot, which enables them to post their Author's Original Manuscript (AOM) or Accepted Manuscript (AM) to any subject or institutional repository immediately upon publication.

Taylor & Francis has now extended this pilot to include journals in our Archives and Heritage list (see the full list of journals at bit.ly/2gneSIC).

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Authors who choose to publish in these journals are no longer asked to assign copyright. They now sign a license to publish, which allows Taylor & Francis to publish the Version of Record. Additionally, authors can choose to make their work green open access with no embargos applied.

Authors publishing in Library and Information Science and Archives and Heritage journals are exempt from any embargo on the Accepted Manuscript (AM) version (see bit.ly/2fTG3tX) of their article (the AM is the version of your article that has been through peer review and accepted by a journal editor). This means you can post your AM to subject or institutional repositories, as well as to your personal or departmental websites, immediately upon publication. This includes posting to Facebook, Google Groups, and LinkedIn, and linking from Twitter (the same conditions apply to posting of the Author Original Manuscript, your draft article).

To encourage citation of your work we recommend that you insert a link from your posted AM to the published article on Taylor & Francis Online (tandfonline.com) with the following text:

This is an Accepted Manuscript of an article published by Taylor & Francis in [JOURNAL TITLE] on [date of publication], available online: http://www.tandfonline.com/ [Article DOI].

This is an Accepted Manuscript of an article published by Taylor & Francis Group in *Africa Review* on 17/04/2014, available online:


