Expenditure: This graph shows the percentage of ALIA's expenditure on each of the segmented items, you can click on any segment of interest to see a more detailed description.

Member Resources: This category includes the costs associated with providing various Member benefits including access to EBL ebooks and Proquest's LIS journals through the Member Centre

Business Management: This category includes the wider cost of running the team at ALIA House and the State and Territory Managers, including Human Resources and Finance.

ICT: This category includes expenses for the acquisition and upkeep of the electronic devices at ALIA House, as well as the database upkeep and upgrades, and website support.

Advocacy & Stakeholder Relations: This category includes funding for all of ALIA's advocacy work, including campaigns, such as Library Lovers' Day and Library and Information Week, as well as government submissions, such as the recent *Australian libraries support the Sustainable Development Goals*.

Conferences: This category includes the costs associated with holding and hosting all ALIA conferences and symposiums like the Asia-Pacific Library and Information Conference on the Gold Coast 30 July - 2 August 2018.

ALIA House: This category includes expense for the maintenance and upgrades of ALIA House and the grounds, as well as insurance for the building and rates.

Education, PD & Training: This category includes all the costs associated with running the Education, Training and PD opportunities ALIA creates for its Members. These include the accreditation of LIS courses and the PD Scheme.

Publishing & Communications: This category includes expenses for the editing, design and production of *INCITE*, the *Journal of the Australian Library and Information Association*, *ALIA Weekly*, and all of the other communication channels that ALIA House uses, including our social media.
