# AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 30 of 1938.

## AN ORDINANCE

### To amend the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1937.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1938*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1937* as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1938*.

2. Section four of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1937* is amended— Constitution of the Advisory Council.

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words “Works and Services” and inserting in their stead the words “Canberra Services”; and
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the word “Civil” and inserting in its stead the word “Civic”.
