# AN ORDINANCE

### To amend the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1937.

**B** it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be eited as the Advisory Council Short title Ordinance 1938.

(2.) The Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1937 as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1938.

2. Section four of the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1937 Constitution of the Advisory is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "Works and Services" and inserting in their stead the words "Canberra Services"; and
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the word "Civil" and inserting in its stead the word "Civie".
