ADVISORY COUNCIL ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Advisory Council Short title and citation. Ordinance (No. 2) 1973.\*

(2) Section 1 of the Advisory Council Ordinance 1973 is amended by omitting sub-section (2).

(3) The Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1969, † is amended by the Advisory Council Ordinance 1973<sup>‡</sup> and by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1973.

2. Section 9 of the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1969, as Allowance amended by the Advisory Council Ordinance 1973, is amended—

- to elected members.
- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) the words "Eight hundred dollars" and substituting the words "Two thousand dollars ": and
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (2) the words "Four hundred dollars" and substituting the words "One thousand five hundred dollars".
