ADVISORY COUNCIL ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance (No. 2) 1973*.^{*} Short title
and citation.

(2) Section 1 of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1973* is amended by omitting sub-section (2).

(3) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1969*,[†] is amended by the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1973*[‡] and by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1973*.

2. Section 9 of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1969*, as amended by the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1973*, is amended— Allowance
to elected
members.

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1) the words "Eight hundred dollars" and substituting the words "Two thousand dollars"; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (2) the words "Four hundred dollars" and substituting the words "One thousand five hundred dollars".
