AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1939.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1939, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra Short title Community Hospital Ordinance 1940.
- (2.) The Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1939 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1940.
- 2. Section thirty of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—
- "(1.) The Board shall keep full and particular accounts of all moneys received and expended by it. The accounts of moneys received shall be so kept that the revenue derived from persons paying Hospital Tax and their dependants shall be shown separately from that derived from other persons".
