An Ordinance to amend the Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Nurses Registration (Amendment) Ordinance 1982.

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933.²

Repeal of section 18

3. Section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

Registration

- 4. Section 22B of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (4) and substituting the following sub-section:
- "(4) Upon a person becoming registered in accordance with this section and paying to the Capital Territory Health Commission the prescribed fee, the Board shall issue to the person a certificate of registration in the prescribed form."

Enrolment

5. Section 28G of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (3) and substituting the following sub-section:

"(3) Upon a person becoming enrolled in accordance with this section and paying to the Capital Territory Health Commission a fee of seventy-five cents, the Board shall issue to the person a certificate of enrolment.".
