An Ordinance to amend the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Nurses Registration (Amendment) Ordinance 1982*.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933*.²

Repeal of section 18

3. Section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

Registration

4. Section 22B of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (4) and substituting the following sub-section:

"(4) Upon a person becoming registered in accordance with this section and paying to the Capital Territory Health Commission the prescribed fee, the Board shall issue to the person a certificate of registration in the prescribed form."

Enrolment

5. Section 28G of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (3) and substituting the following sub-section:

“(3) Upon a person becoming enrolled in accordance with this section and paying to the Capital Territory Health Commission a fee of seventy-five cents, the Board shall issue to the person a certificate of enrolment.”.
