### No. 36 of 1970

#### An Ordinance to amend the *Optometrists Ordinance* 1956-1967.

Short title  
and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Optometrists Ordinance* 1970.\*

(2.) The *Optometrists Ordinance* 1956-1967,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Optometrists Ordinance* 1956-1970.

Allowances  
to witnesses.

2. Section 42 of the *Optometrists Ordinance* 1956-1967 is amended—

(a) by omitting sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—

“ (1.) A person who attends for the purpose of giving evidence before the Board is entitled to receive such fees and travelling expenses in accordance with the scale in the Second Schedule to the Public Works Committee Regulations as in force from time to time under the *Public Works Committee Act* 1969 as the Chairman or, if the Chairman is absent from the meeting of the Board, the Deputy Chairman determines.”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the word “allowances” and inserting in its stead the word “expenses”.
