## An Act to amend the Parliamentary Presiding Officers Act 1965

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

#### Short title etc.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Presiding Officers Amendment Act 1987.
- (2) The Parliamentary Presiding Officers Act 1965<sup>1</sup> is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

### Presiding Officer to be deemed to continue to be Presiding Officer after resignation

- 2. Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended:
  - (a) by inserting "or her" after "his" (wherever occurring); and
  - (b) by inserting "or she" after "he" (wherever occurring).

- 3. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended:
- (a) by inserting "or her" after "his"; and
- (b) by inserting "or she" after "he" (wherever occurring).
