

# Appropriation (No. 1) 1965-66

No. 67 of 1965

An Act to appropriate a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.

[Assented to 12 November, 1965]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act (No. 1)* 1965-66. Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent. Commencement.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply for the services specified in the Second Schedule to this Act, in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, the sum of Six hundred and ninety-one million two hundred and ninety-one thousand pounds. 4. The sums authorized by the *Supply Act (No. 1) 1965-66* and by this Act to be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, amounting, as appears by the First Schedule to this Act, in the aggregate to the sum of One thousand and eighty-nine million nine hundred and forty-five thousand pounds, are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, for the services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in respect of the financial year that commenced on that date.
