Appropriation (No. 1) 1972-73

No. 104 of 1972

An Act to appropriate certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.

[Assented to 31 October 1972]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act (No. 1) 1972–73.

Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commencethe Royal Assent.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and Issue and apply for the services specified in the Second Schedule to this Act, in \$1,924,254,000. respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-three, the sum of One thousand, nine hundred and twenty-four million, two hundred and fifty-four thousand dollars.

4. The sums authorized by the Supply Act (No. 1) 1972-73 and by the Appropriation last preceding section to be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, \$\frac{01}{53},242,044,000, amounting, as appears by the First Schedule to this Act, in the aggregate to the sum of Three thousand, two hundred and forty-two million and forty-four thousand dollars are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, for the services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in respect of the financial year that commenced on that date.

5.—(1.) In addition to the sum appropriated by the last preceding Further issue, section, the Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund appropriation. and apply, in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-three, such sums as the Treasurer from time to time determines.

(2.) The sums determined by the Treasurer under the last preceding sub-section are appropriated for the purposes of the Loan Consolidation and Investment Reserve established by the Loan Consolidation and Investment Reserve Act 1955.
