APPROPRIATION, 1904-5.

No. 15 of 1904.

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and five and to appropriate the supplies granted for such year in this session of the Parliament.

[Assented to 15th December, 1904.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Preamble. Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1904-5.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and application of Fund, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted #2,046,008. to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and five, the sum of Two million forty-six thousand and eight pounds.

3. All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned Appropriation of supplies, in the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue £3,915,286. Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Three million nine hundred and fifteen thousand two hundred and eighty-six pounds, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 4 of 1904 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule.
