Directions to be gazetted and tabled in Parliament. "157F. Any direction issued by the Minister in pursuance of section one hundred and fifty-seven B, one hundred and fifty-seven c, or one hundred and fifty-seven D of the Act shall—

(a) be published in the Gazette;

- (b) take effect from the date of publication or from a date specified in the direction; and
- (c) be laid before both Houses of the Parliament within seven days after the date of publication or, if the Parliament is not then sitting, then within seven days after the next meeting of the Parliament;

but if either House of the Parliament passes a resolution, of which notice has been given at any time within fifteen sitting days after the direction has been laid before that House, disallowing the direction, the direction shall thereupon cease to have effect."

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Short title.

Issue and application of £18,796,363.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1920-21.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one the sum of Eighteen million seven hundred and ninety-six thousand three hundred and sixty-three pounds. Appropriation 1920–21.

3. All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned in Appropriation the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Twenty-seven million eight hundred and sixty-one thousand five hundred and ninety-six pounds, are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 16 of 1920 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.
