APPROPRIATION 1923-24.

No. 36 of 1923.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four and to appropriate the Supplies granted by the Parliament for such vear.

[Assented to 1st September, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1923-24. Short title.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and application of Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted £14,776,521. to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four the sum of Fourteen million seven hundred and seventy-six thousand five hundred and twenty-one pounds.

3. All sums granted by this Act and the other Act mentioned in Appropriation the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund £18,930,606. towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Eighteen million nine hundred and thirty thousand six hundred and six pounds are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 1 of 1923 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four.
