

## ALIENS REGISTRATION ACT SUSPENSION.

No. 17 of 1926.

An Act to suspend the Operation of the *Aliens  
Registration Act 1920.*

[Assented to 4th June, 1926.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Aliens Registration Act Suspensioni* Short title.  
*Act 1926.*

2. The operation of the *Aliens Registration Act 1920*\* is hereby Suspension of

suspended until a date to be fixed by Proclamation, on which date the suspension shall cease.

## AUDIT.

No. 18 of 1926.

An Act to amend the *Audit Act 1901-1924.*

[Assented to 4th June, 1926.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Audit Act 1926.*

(2.) The *Audit Act 1901-1924*\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Audit Act 1901-1926*.

Salary of  
Auditor-  
General.

2. Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "One thousand five hundred" and inserting in their stead the words "One thousand seven hundred and fifty".

3. After section five of the Principal Act the following section is inserted :—

Auditor-General  
to retire at  
sixty-five.

"5A. The Auditor-General for the Commonwealth shall cease to hold office upon attaining the age of sixty-five years."

An Act to amend the *Northern Territory  
(Administration) Act 1910*.

[Assented to 11th June, 1926.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

Short title and  
citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1926*.

(2.) The *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910\** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1926*.

Definition of  
Minister.

2. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "the Minister".

Disposal  
of Crown Lands.

3. Section eleven of the Principal Act is repealed.
