This Note in conjunction with your communication of 31st August, 1935, will be regarded as an agreement between our two Governments in this matter with effect from 1st July 1935,

PROVIDED that this agreement shall lapse if not ratified by the Parliament of the Union of South Africa by resolution of both Houses, during the next ensuing session, and by the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia, and

PROVIDED FURTHER that, if ratified, it shall be terminable by six months' notice

on either side.

APPROPRIATION 1936-37.

No. 59 of 1936.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven and to appropriate the Supplies granted by the Parliament for that year.

[Assented to 27th November, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1936-37.

Short title.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted application of £14,316,363. to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of Jone One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven the sum of Fourteen million three hundred and sixteen thousand three hundred and sixty-three pounds.

3. All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned in Appropriation the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of supply £25,967,913. towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Twenty-five million nine hundred and fifty-seven thousand nine hundred and thirteen pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first of July One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven.

Application of Financial Emergency Act 1931-1985. 4. The amounts respectively provided by this Act for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule shall, in so far as they relate to any offices, be subject to such reductions (if any) as are authorized to be made by or under the *Financial Emergency Act* 1931–1935 in respect of the salaries of persons holding those offices.
