# APPROPRIATION 1943-44.

### No. 56 of 1943.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-four and to appropriate the Supplies granted by the Parliament for that year.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1943.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1943-44.

Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement. receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, the sum of One hundred and ten million eight hundred and seven thousand pounds.

Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-four, amounting as appears by that Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of One hundred and eighty million six hundred and fifty-seven thousand pounds, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty-three, for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-four.
