APPROPRIATION 1949-50.

No. 42 of 1949.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, and to appropriate the Supplies granted by the Parliament for that year.

[Assented to 27th October, 1949.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1949-50.

Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement. receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, the sum of Ninetytwo million five hundred and ninety-four thousand pounds.

4. All sums granted by this Act and the other Act mentioned Appropriation in the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue \$\frac{6}{2164,152,000}\$. Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, amounting as appears by that Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of One hundred and sixty-four million one hundred and fifty-two thousand pounds, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty.
