Appropriation (No. 2) 1966-67

No. 46 of 1966

An Act to appropriate a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for certain expenditure in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June. One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven.

[Assented to 21 October, 1966]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act (No. 2) short title. 1966 67.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which commenceit receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and application of Fund and apply for the services specified in the Second Schedule \$343,369,000. to this Act, in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, the sum of Three hundred and forty-three million three hundred and sixty-nine thousand dollars.

4. The sums authorized by the Supply Act (No. 2) 1966-67 Appropriation and by this Act to be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue \$546,576,000. Fund, amounting, as appears by the First Schedule to this Act, in the aggregate to the sum of Five hundred and forty-six million five hundred and seventy-six thousand dollars are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, for the services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in respect of the financial year that commenced on that date.
