An Act to appropriate a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for certain expenditure in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy.

[Assented to 27 September 1969]

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act (No. 2) 1969-70.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives commencethe Roval Assent.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund Issue and IST and apply for the services specified in the Second Schedule to this Act, in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy, the sum of Three hundred and seventy-six million, two hundred and fifty-four thousand dollars.

4. The sums authorized by the Supply Act (No. 2) 1969-70 and by this Appropriation of \$597.794 000. Act to be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, amounting, as appears by the First Schedule to this Act, in the aggregate to the sum of Five hundred and ninety-seven million seven hundred and ninety-four thousand dollars are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July. One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine for the services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in respect of the financial year that commenced on that date.
