## APPROPRIATION (WORKS AND BUILDINGS) (No. 2) 1932-33.

### No. 63 of 1932.

An Act to grant and apply an additional sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c., and to appropriate such sum.

[Assented to 5th December, 1932.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble.  
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Works and Buildings) (No. 2) Act 1932-33.* Short title.

Issue and application of £45,920.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three the sum of Forty-five thousand nine hundred and twenty pounds.

Appropriation.

3. The said sum granted by this Act is appropriated for the purposes and services set forth in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.

An Act to reduce Taxation ; to remove anomalies in relation to Invalid and Old-age Pensions ; to provide Financial Relief for Wheat Growers and other Primary Producers ; and for other purposes.
