BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Presentle. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Works and short title Buildings) (No. 2) Act 1932-33.

Issue and application of £45,920.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three the sum of Forty-five thousand nine hundred and twenty pounds.
