# APPROPRIATION 

(Works and Buimings).

No. 5 of 1909.

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and ten for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, \&c.
[Assented to 4th September, 1909.]

$\mathrm{B}^{\mathrm{I}}$E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :-

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Works and short title. Buildings) Act 1909-10.
2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and Fund, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted application of to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and ten the sum of One million and fifty-four thousand one hundred and twenty-four pounds.
3. The said sum granted by this Act is hereby appropriated for Appropriation the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule.
