BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Works and Short title. Services) Act 1949-50.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement, receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted application of £54,599,000. to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, the sum of Fifty-four million five hundred and ninety-nine thousand pounds.

4. All sums granted by this Act and the other Act mentioned of supply in the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue 268,203,000. Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, amounting as appears by that Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Sixty-eight million two hundred and ninety-three thousand pounds, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—
