ALUMINIUM INDUSTRY.

An Act to amend the Aluminium Industry Act 1944-1954 in relation to the Employment of Persons by the Australian Aluminium Production Commission.

[Assented to 15th November, 1956.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Aluminium Industry Act short utte 1956.

(2.) The Aluminium Industry Act 1944-1954* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Aluminium Industry Act 1944-1956.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the commencement. twenty-third day of October, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

3. After section eleven of the Principal Act the following section is inserted :---

"11A. The Public Service Arbitration Act 1920-1956 does not apply Public Service in relation to the employment of officers or employees of the Commission.".

4. Notwithstanding the amendment made by this Act, a determination which, immediately before the commencement of this Act, was in force under the *Public Service Arbitration Act* 1920-1956 and applied in relation to persons appointed or employed by the Australian Aluminium Production Commission continues to apply as if section eleven \mathbf{A} had not been inserted in the Principal Act, but is subject to any award, order, determination or agreement made under any other Act after the commencement of this Act.
