D E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, J and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Re-exports Short title and Act 1947.

(2.) The New Zealand Re-exports Act 1924*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the New Zealand Re-exports Act 1924-1947.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Commencement. Proclamation.

3. Section three of the New Zealand Re-exports Act 1924 is Value for duty, of goods amended-

- (a) by adding at the end of paragraph (b) of sub-section (1.) the Australia from New Ze land, word "and";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) of sub-section (1.) the word " and ";
- (c) by omitting paragraph (d) of sub-section (1.);
- (d) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-section (4.) the word "and"; and
- (e) by omitting paragraph (c) of sub-section (4.).

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

PART I.---PRELIMINARY.

Short title.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Objects.

3. The several objects of this Act include—

1. This Act may be cited as the Banking Act 1947.

- (a) the expansion of the banking business of the Commonwealth Bank as a publicly-owned bank conducted in the interests of the people of Australia and not for private profit;
- (b) the taking over by the Commonwealth Bank of the banking business in Australia of private banks and the acquisition on just terms of property used in that business;
- (c) the prohibition of the carrying on of banking business ir Australia by private banks.
